2. Duties of Nodal Officers would be as under:

- (i) As MOTA representative official, analysis of TSP of concerned States and performance of State administration against predetermined parameters.
- (ii) Participation in PAC and other committees for approval of MOTA programmes in their States.
- (iii) Each official would be responsible for monitoring project implementation and utilization of funds.
- (iv) Analysis of problem in implementation and suggest proper initiatives for systemic concrete steps / structural changes.
- (v) Visit States and evaluation of ongoing tribal development activities.
- (vi) Assessment of extant deficit against development parameters in tribal areas and suggest measures needed for gap filling.
- (vii) Prepare briefs for use of Hon'ble Prime Minister / Ministers / Secretary, TA during their visits to States.
- (viii) Gender budgeting to be monitored scheme wise for that particular State.
- (ix) Review of Tribal Districts included in 115 backward district list of NITI Aayog.
