Subject: Release of Grant under 1st proviso to Article 275(1) of the Constitution during 2013-14 to the State Government of Jharkhand – sanction of 2nd installment (General- recurring).

Sir,

In continuation to this Ministry's sanction letter of even no. dated 29.09.2013, I am directed to refer to the subject mentioned above and to convey the sanction of the President to the grants-in-aid (recurring) and to release **Rs.15,30,90,000.00 (Rupees fifteen crore thirty lakh ninety thousand only), as 2nd installment** to the government of **Jharkhand** under Article 275(1) of the Constitution for the year 2013-14 towards General Grant. The conditions/terms indicated in the sanction letter dated 29.09.2013 would *mutis-mutandis* apply to the State Government for all releases under Article 275(1) of the Constitution. 2. You are requested to advise RBI, CAS, Nagpur for crediting the above mentioned amount to the account of the Government of **Jharkhand** in accordance with procedure laid down in the Ministry of Finance's OM No. 2(45)/ 76-Spl Cell dated 30.8.1976 as modified by OM of even number dated 16.9.1976.

3. The expenditure is debitible to the:

- Major Head '3601' - Grants-in-aid to State Governments,
- Sub-major Head 02 - Grants for State Plan Schemes,
- Minor Head 796 - Tribal Area Sub-Plan
 - 01 - Welfare of Scheduled Tribes – Grants under Proviso to Article 275 (1) of the Constitution.
 - 02 - Scheme under Proviso to Article 275(1) of the Constitution (Charged)
 - 01.02.31 - Grants in-aid - General (Charged)
- Demand No. - 95 for 2013-14 of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs

4. The entire assistance is subject to adjustment on the basis of the audited figures of expenditure for the State Annual Plan 2013-14.

5. The State Government will implement the projects within the amount released by the Ministry during 2013-14 and keeping in view spirit of the guideline laid down on Grants under Article 275(1) of the Constitution vide its letter No. 14011/9/2001-SG&C dated 2-7-2002 & D.O. letter No. 14020/2/2008-SG-1 dated 30.01.2008 and other instructions issued from time to time.

6. **Due diligence may be adhered to by the State Government for complying Model Code of Conduct issued by Election Commission of India regarding General Election, 2014 while incurring expenditure out of this sanction.**

7. This sanction issues in exercise of the delegated powers in consultation with Integrated Finance of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs vide their **Diary No.735/JS&FA/2014 dated 27.03.2014.**
