**Subject: Release of Central Assistance under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of "Research and Training-Grants in aid to TRIs" to Tribal research Institute, Govt. of Karnataka, Mysore, during the year 2013-2014.**

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for the release of an amount of **Rs. 29,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Nine Lakhs only)** as grant-in-aid to the State Government of Karnataka as Central Share for Tribal research Institute, Govt. of Karnataka, Mysore, under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme "Research & Training- Grant-in-aid to Tribal Research Institutes" for 2013-14. The details of the activities approved to by the Ministry are as under-

2. The above mentioned amount is sanctioned under the scheme "Research Information & Mass Education, Tribal Festivals and others (Research & Training- Grants to Tribal Research Institutes) during 2013-14 (Non-recurring).

3. The details of activities undertaken should be indicated invariably in the quarterly progress reports.

4. State Govt. shall submit the information to this Ministry within three months from the date of receipt of this order. (i) A brief note on the activities taken by the Tribal research Institute, Govt. of Karnataka, Mysore, during last three years and expenditure incurred thereon, (ii) the agenda set by TRI and the result acquired from them. (iii) Details of improvements/changes made in the approach to the development of scheduled tribes in the State of Karnataka during last year.

5. The Grants-in-aid is subjected to the General Financial Rules, 2005, as amended from time to time, read with the Government of India's decisions incorporated there-under, and any other guidelines which may be issued in this regard, and in particular to the following conditions:-

- i) All relevant information and documents/certificates as required under GFR-209 shall be furnished by the grantee.
- ii) Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of Government Grants shall not be disposed of without obtaining the prior approval of the sanctioning authority of Grant-in-aid.
- iii) The grantee will not obtain grant for the same purpose or activity (the purpose of which grant is sanctioned to it under the Scheme of "Research Information & Mass Education, Tribal Festivals and others") from any other Ministry or Department of Govt. of India or State Government.
- iv) The grantee institution agrees to make reservations for scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes or OBC in the posts or services under its control on the lines indicated by Govt. of India.
- v) The accounts of grantee institution, shall be open for inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller & Auditor General of India under the provision of A&AG (DPC Act, 1971) and Internal Audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department whenever it is called upon to do so.
- vi) The grantee should furnish their performance-cum-achievement report within the three months of the date of receiving the grant, to the sanctioning Authority.
- vii) The grantee will maintain and present their annual accounts in the standard format as required under GFR - 209.
- ix) The grantee will maintain subsidiary accounts of the Govt. grant as required under GFR 210.

- I. Audited figures duly certified by the Chartered Accountant.
- II. Utilisation certificate of the sanctioned amount by Chartered Accountant.

6. It certified that the pattern of assistance and rules governing the grants-in-aid have received the approval of Ministry of Finance.

7. The Central Share should not be diverted for any other activities.

8. The Utilization Certificates for the grant received for the purpose for which it was sanctioned, is to be furnished by the grantee organization as per rule 212 of GFR.

9. The expenditure is debitable to the Major Head "3601", Grants-in-aid to State Governments, 04-Grants for the Centrally Sponsored Plan Schemes (Sub-Major-Head), 796-Tribal Area Sub Plan (Minor-Head), 27- Welfare of Scheduled Tribes - Education, 05- Research Information & Mass Education, Tribal Festivals & Others 27.05.31 - Grants-in-aid - General (charged) under Demand No. 95 of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs for 2013-14 (Plan) (Non-recurring).

10. The financial assistance sanctioned is provisional subject to final adjustment on the basis of audited figures of expenditure.

11. The sanction is issued with the concurrence Integrated Finance Division, Ministry of Tribal Affairs vide their Dy. No. 767/JS&FA/14 dated 29.3.14
