Sub: Conservation-cum-development (CCD) Plan for Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs) of Tripura for 12th Five Year Plan under the Scheme of Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups - Grant for creation of Capital Assets (3rd instalment) to the State Govt. of Tripura for 2014-15 thereof.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the letter of State Govt. of Tripura No.F.12-20/CCDP/DEV/TRP&PTG/12/1959 dated 19/09/2014 from the Government of Tripura regarding Conservation-cum-Development (CCD) Plan for Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs) of Tripura for 12th Five Year Plan and to convey the sanction of the President to the release of Grant-in-aid for creation of Capital Assets for an amount of Rs.85,07,000/- (Rs. Eighty Five Lakh Seven Thousand only) towards 3rd instalment for the year 2014-15 to State Government of Tripura under the Central Sector Scheme of "Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs)" for the activities/works as proposed in the CCD Plan for the year 2014-15.

2. The grant-in-aid shall be subject to provisions of GFR, 2005.
3. The funds shall be released by the State Government of Tripura for onward transmission to the implementing agencies within one month of issue of this sanction order.
4. The approved works/activities as per Annexure-I shall be taken up in accordance with an implementation schedule drawn by Social Welfare Department of the State and submitted to the Ministry. Programme planning and monitoring must be done at local level primarily-preferably involving SHGs and similar village institutions.
5. The non-recurring grant is to be spent within 12 months from the date of sanction of this grant. The Utilization Certificate for non-recurring and recurring grant will be submitted by the State Govt. to the Ministry within 12 months from the date of sanction of this grant.
6. The State Government shall ensure that there is no unspent balance out of this grant left with them at the end period mentioned in para 5 above. The Unspent balance, if any, will be surrendered to the Ministry of Tribal Affairs.
7. The financial assistance as provided under the scheme has been approved by Ministry of Finance. It shall be utilized for the purpose it has been sanctioned and for the welfare of members of PTGs only.
