Subject: Release of Rs 73,50,00,000/- (Rupees Seventy Three Crores and Fifty Lakhs only) as Grant-in-aid to the Chhattisgarh State Minor Forest Produce (Trading & Development) Cooperative Federation Ltd. Raipur (CGMFPFED) for the year 2015-16 under the Scheme "Mechanism for Marketing of Minor Forest Produce (MFP) through Minimum Support Price (MSP) and development of Value Chain for MFP".

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to the Grant-in-Aid of **Rs 73,50,00,000/- (Rupees Seventy Three Crores and Fifty Lakhs only)** and to the release of **Rs 73,50,00,000/- (Rupees Seventy Three Crores and Fifty Lakhs only)** for the financial year 2015-16 to the Chhattisgarh State Minor Forest Produce (Trading & Development) Cooperative Federation Ltd. Raipur (CGMFPFED) under the Scheme "Mechanism for Marketing of Minor Forest Produce (MFP) through Minimum Support Price (MSP) and development of Value Chain for MFP".

2. The present release of **Rs 73,50,00,000/- (Rupees Seventy Three Crores and Fifty Lakhs only)** is towards Government of India (GOI) share for revolving funds/working capital component of the scheme, estimated on the basis of procurement potential of Tamarind and Lac in the State of Chhattisgarh. This release is inclusive of Rs. 10.84 crore, the balance revolving fund of the previous financial year. Therefore, with this release, the total GOI share release amounts to Rs. 153.66 crore towards the revolving fund out of the total estimated potential of MFP of Rs. 205.00 crore. The State Government Share will be 25% of the total estimated value i.e. **Rs.51.25 crores only (Rupees Fifteen One crore and twenty one lakh only)**.

3. The Grants-in-aid will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in the Scheme "Mechanism for Marketing of Minor Forest Produce (MFP) through Minimum Support Price (MSP) and development of Value Chain for MFP" as circulated vide Ministry of Tribal Affairs letter No. 2/19/2013-CP&R dated 03.01.2014.

4. The Grants-in-aid is also subject to the Chapter 9 of the General Financial Rules, 2005 (GFRs), as amended from time to time, read with the Government of India's decisions incorporated there-under, and any other guidelines which may be issued in this regard, and in particular to the following conditions:
