Sub: Conservation-cum-development (CCD) Plan of Govt of Rajasthan for 12th Five Year Plan period under the Scheme of Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs) - release of Grant-in-Aid (**General**) to the State Govt. of Rajasthan (*1st instalment*) for the year 2015-16.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the letter No.F7(1)Saharia /CCD/2014-15/7750 dated 31.03.2015 from the Government of Rajasthan regarding Conservation-cum-Development (CCD Plan) for Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs) of Rajasthan for 12th Five Year and to convey the sanction of the President to the release **Grant-in-aid (General)** for an amount of **Rs.5,38,04,500/-** (Rupees Five Crore Thirty Eight Lakh Four thousand Five hundred only) towards *1st Instalment* for the year 2015-16 for **General activities as per Annexure** to the State Government of Rajasthan under the Central Sector Scheme of "**Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs)**" for the activities/works proposed in the CCD Plan for the year 2015-16. No U.C. is due for rendition.

2. The grant-in-aid shall be subject to provisions of GFR, 2005.
3. The funds shall be released by the State Government of Rajasthan for onward transmission to the implementing agencies **within one month** of issue of this sanction order.
4. The works/activities shall be taken up in accordance with an implementation schedule submitted by Department of Tribal & Scheduled Caste Welfare of the State and submitted to the Ministry.
5. The non-recurring grant is to be spent within 12 months from the date of sanction of this grant. The Utilization Certificate for non-recurring and recurring grant will be submitted by the State Govt. to the Ministry within 12 months from the date of sanction of this grant.
6. The State Government shall ensure that there is no unspent balance out of this grant left with them at the end of current financial year. The Unspent balance, if any, will be surrendered to the Ministry of Tribal Affairs.
7. The financial assistance as provided under the scheme has been approved by Ministry of Finance. It shall be utilized for the purpose it has been sanctioned and for the welfare of members of PTGs only.
8. The financial assistance given to ITDPs/ITDAs and TRIs should be deemed to have been given to the State Government concerned and rules and regulation governing the grants-in-aid to States/UTs shall apply to them.
