reimbursement basis.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Letter No.07/NGO-09/2013-K-2446 dated 09/10/2014 from the Government of Jharkhand and to convey the sanction of the President of India for releasing of Grant-in-aid of **Rs.4,20,564/- (Rupees Four Lakh Twenty Thousand Five Hundred Sixty Four only)** towards **full & final instalment for the year 2014-15** on reimbursement basis as per details of Expenditure enclosed as Annexure-I, after adjusting Rs.1,49,966/- on account of unspent balance as per auditor's report & audited accounts for the years 2013-14 {as detailed in Annexure-I in respect of grants for the year 2014-15} to **Ramakrishna Mission Math**, At/PO/Distt- **Jamtara- 815 351, Jharkhand** for running & maintenance of ongoing project of **Mobile Dispensary** under the scheme of Grants-in-aid to voluntary organisations working for the welfare of scheduled tribes during the year 2015-16. No utilisation certificate is due for rendition. The grant-in-aid shall be subject to provisions of GFR-2005. The list of documents to be maintained as per GFR is indicated in Annexure-II.

2. Since the grant has been sanctioned by way of reimbursement of expenditure already incurred on the basis of duly audited accounts, no UC is required in respect of sanctioned amount in terms of Note 1 of Rule No. 212(1) of GFR.
3. The accounts of all grantee Institutions/organisations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or organization is called to do so.
4. The members of the executive committee of the grantee organisation should execute bonds in a prescribed format that they themselves jointly and severally:-
  - (a) abide by the conditions of the grants-in-aid by the target dates, if any, specified therein;
