Subject:- Grant-in-aid to **Bharat Sevashram Sangha (Raiganj Branch)**, AT-Raiganj, PO-Debinagar, District-Uttar Dinajpur, Pin-733 123, **West Bengal** as recurring expenses for running and maintenance of ongoing project namely Mobile Dispensary for Scheduled Tribes at Raiganj, PO-Debinagar, District-Uttar Dinajpur, PIN-733123, West Bengal towards full and final instalment for the year 2014-15 on reimbursement of expenditure basis during the current financial year 2015-16.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the letter no.197-TDD/12S-35/2014 dated 04.03.2015 received from Government of West Bengal and to convey the sanction of the President of India to the payment of grant-in-aid of **Rs.7,06,950/-(Rupees Seven Lakhs Six Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty only)** as per details of Recurring expenditure enclosed as Annexure-I, after adjusting unspent balance of Rs.Nil for ongoing project of Mobile Dispensary to the organisation Bharat Sevashram Sangha, at Raiganj, PO-Debinagar, District-Uttar Dinajpur, PIN-733123, West Bengal towards full and final instalment for the year 2014-15 on reimbursement of expenditure basis during the current financial year 2015-16. No Utilization Certificates are due for rendition and awaited at present. The grant-in-aid shall be subject to the provisions of GFR, 2005.

2. Since the grant has been sanctioned by way of reimbursement of expenditure already incurred on the basis of duly audited accounts, no UC is required in respect of sanctioned amount in terms of Note 1 of Rule 212 (I) of GFR.

4. The accounts of all grantee Institutions/organisations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organisation is called upon to do so.

5. The members of the executive committee of the grantee organisation should execute bonds in a prescribed format that they themselves jointly and severally:-
