
Subject:- Grant-in-aid for the year 2013-14 to Swami Vivekananda Youth Movement, Saragur, District Mysore, Karnataka for maintenance & running of ongoing projects namely (i) Residential Primary School (Res+Non-Res), at Hosahalli, HD Kote Taluk, HD Kote Taluk (ii) Residential School (Secondary) at Hosahalli HD Kote Taluk, , (iii) 10-Bedded Hospital at Kennchanahalli (iv) 10-Bedded Hospital at Saragur (v) Mobile Dispensary at Saragur, District Mysore, Karnataka.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to letter No.SWD 278 PaVaYo2013 dated 25.6.2014 from Government of Karnataka on the subject mentioned above and to convey the sanction of the President of India for grant-in-aid of Rs.76,96,215/- and to release **Rs.69,26,594/- (Rupees Sixty Nine Lakhs Twenty Six Thousand Five Hundred Ninety Four only)** towards full & final installment **for the year 2013-14** during the year 2015-16 (after adjusting an amount of Rs.1,09,500/- towards sale proceeds of unserviceable goods as per details given at Annexure.I, and after withholding 10% of admissible amount equivalent to Rs.769621/-, which will be considered for release after the organization achieves 100% immunization of pregnant mothers and children in the area) to **Swami Vivekananda Youth Movement, Saragur, District Mysore, Karnataka** as per details of recurring expenditure enclosed as Annexure-I for ongoing projects namely (i) **Residential Primary School (Res+Non-Res), at Hosahalli, HD Kote Taluk** (ii) **Residential School (Secondary) at Hosahalli HD Kote Taluk, (iii) 10-Bedded Hospital at Kennchanahalli (iv) 10-Bedded Hospital at Saragur, HD Kote Taluk** and (v) **Mobile Dispensary at Saragur, District Mysore, Karnataka**. No Utilization Certificates are due for rendition and awaited at present. The grant-in-aid shall be subject to the provisions of GFR, 2005. The list of documents to be maintained as per GFR is indicated in Annexure.II.

2. *Since there is high MMR and IMR among ST population, the organization shall achieve 100% immunization of pregnant mothers and children in their area. A report in this regard may be submitted within six months of release of grants.*

3. Since the grant-in-aid has been sanctioned by way of reimbursement of expenditure already incurred on the basis of duly audited accounts, no UC is required in respect of sanctioned amount in terms of Note 1 below Rule No.212(1) of GFR.
