

Sub: Conservation-cum-Development (CCD) Plan of **Govt of Chhattisgarh** for 12<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan under the Scheme of **Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs) - Grant-in-Aid for Creation of Capital Assets to Govt. of Chhattisgarh for the year 2015-16.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the letter No.F-17-97/2011/25-2 dated 22.7.2015 from the Government of Chhattisgarh regarding Conservation-cum-Development (CCD Plan) for Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs) of **Chhattisgarh** for 12<sup>th</sup> Five Year and to convey the sanction of the President to the sanction of Grants for **creation of capital assets** for an amount of Rs.,7,37,79,000/- (Rupees Seven Crore Thirty Seven Lakh and Seventy Nine Thousand only) and to **release Rs.7,22,77,000/- (Rupees Seven Crore Twenty Two Lakh and Seventy Seven Thousand only)** for the year 2015-16, after adjusting an unspent balance of Rs.15,02,000/- for the year 2013-14 as per Annexure to the State **Government of Chhattisgarh** under the Central Sector Scheme of "**Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs)**" for the priority activities/works proposed in the CCD Plan for the year 2015-16 . No Utilisation certificate is due for rendition

2. The grant-in-aid shall be subject to provisions of GFR, 2005.
3. The funds shall be released by the State Government of Chhattisgarh for onward transmission to the implementing agencies within one month of issue of this sanction order.
4. The works/activities shall be taken up in accordance with an implementation schedule submitted by Scheduled Tribe & Scheduled Caste Development Department of the State to the Ministry.
5. The Utilization Certificate for non-recurring and recurring grant will be submitted by the State Govt. to the Ministry as per Rule 212 of the GFR 205 in Form GFR-19-A.
6. The State Government shall ensure that there is no unspent balance out of this grant left with them at the end of current financial year. The Unspent balance, if any, will be surrendered to the Ministry of Tribal Affairs.
