Subject: Release of Grant under 1st proviso to Article 275 of the Constitution during 2015-16 to the State Government of Nagaland – 2nd Installment.

Sir,

In continuation to this Ministries' sanction letter of even No. dated 10.06.2015, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for release of an amount of **Rs.3,34,80,000/- (Rupees Three Crore Thirty Four Lakh Eighty Thousand Only)** as recurring Grant-in-Aid, as 2nd installment to the Government of Nagaland under Article 275 (1) of the Constitution of India for the year 2015-16 for the following activities as detailed by the State Government in the letter No.PLN-230/MTA/2013 dated 12.03.2015 and letter No.PLN-13/2015(Pt) dated 24.07.2015 followed by presentation made before Project Appraisal Committee (PAC) and finalized by the Project Appraisal Committee in its meeting dated 27.08.2015 as per **Annexure-I**:

2. No UC is due for rendition.
3. You are requested to advise RBI, CAS, Nagpur for crediting the above mentioned amount to the account of the Government of Nagaland in accordance with procedure laid down in the Ministry of Finance's OM No. 2(45)/ 76-Spl Cell dated 30.8.1976 as modified by OM of even number dated 16.9.1976.
4. The expenditure to the tune of **Rs.3,34,80,000/- (Rupees Three Crore Thirty Four Lakh Eighty Thousand Only)** is debitable to the :

Major Head '3601' - Grants-in-aid to State Governments
Sub-major Head 02 - Grants for State Plan Schemes(Sub-Major Head)
Minor Head 796 - Tribal Area Sub-Plan (Minor Head)
02.02.31 - Grants in-aid - General (Charged)
Demand No. - 98 for 2015-16 of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs



5. The entire assistance is subject to adjustment on the basis of the audited figures of expenditure for the State Annual Plan 2015-16.

6. The State Government will implement the projects within the amount released by the Ministry during 2014-15 and keeping in view spirit of the operational guidelines for formulation, implementation and monitoring of TSP and Article 275(1) funds, issued by Ministry of Tribal Affairs during March, 2014 and other relevant instructions / orders issued from time to time.

7. The State Government will adhere to the instructions contained in the Minutes of PaC meetings pertaining to the State(s) concerned scrupulously. Copies of projects implemented by the State Governments is required to be sent to the Ministry. The State Government would ensure that -

- (i) Construction component of the projects is based on the schedule of rates of the State Governments approved by the competent authority.
- (ii) Project(s) has the clearance of the State Government from the technical / financial / administrative angles.

8. The State Government is to transfer fund immediately within 30 days to the project implementing agencies and a copy of the fund transfer order may also be sent to this Ministry. It may be ensured that the grants are used for the purpose for which they are sanctioned after following the due procedure in a transparent manner and obtaining all necessary clearances as required under the various Central/State Acts, Rules and Regulations etc. **Amount released to the tune of Rs. 250.00 lakh(Two Crores Fifty lakhs only) vide sanction order of even number dated 10.06.2015 will be utilized against the hostel activities approved in the PAC meeting dated 27.8.2015.**

9. The progress reports of every quarter should be furnished indicating the physical and financial progress as per prescribed format already circulated. A Certificate of actual utilization of the grants received for the purpose for which it was received, may be furnished to the Ministry within 12 months of the closure of the financial year by the State Government.

10. This sanction issues in exercise of the delegated powers in consultation with Integrated Finance of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs vide their **No.5228/193/JS&FA/2015 dated 17.09.2015.**
