I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for sanction of an amount of **₹.900.00 lakh** and to release of an amount of **₹.2,77,00,000/- (Rupees Two Crore Seventy Seven Lakh Only)**, as 1st installment for creation of capital assets/non-recurring grant to the Government of **Assam** under **Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Plan** for the year **2015-16** to carry out the following activities as finalized/approved by the Project Appraisal Committee(PAC) in its meeting dated 27.04.2015 and revised proposal of skill development received from State Govt. through email on 18.9.2015:-

(i) Horticulture programme for SHGs (ii) Setting up of nursery for SHGs. The PAC approved an amount of ₹.400.00 lakh as an additive with the condition to utilize the funds in convergence with the State TSP funds and Centrally Sponsored Schemes (for example: National Horticulture Mission) as a part of VKY strategy and include: (i) Setting up of nurseries of fruits, flowers, vegetables through tribal beneficiaries with linkages to the market to enable them for sustainable income generation. (ii) Growing and use of drum stick / beans / green leafy vegetables among the tribal people be promoted to help nutrition. (iii) Promotion and practice of Kitchen Garden in the Government run tribal residential schools. (iv) Promotion and practice of apiculture. (v) Use of flowers for agarbatti manufacturing. (vi) Cultivation of fodder like Napier. (vii) Integrate Horticulture and vegetable growing activities with Dairy development programmes to utilize the organic manures for optimum results.
