Sir,

In continuation of this Ministry's sanction of even No. dated 08.03.2017, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for release of an amount of **Rs. 17,27,12,000/- (Rupees Seventeen Crore Twenty Seven Lakh Twelve Thousand Only)**, as 5<sup>th</sup> instalment to the Government of **Chhattisgarh** towards **Creation of Capital Assets (CCA)** under Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Plan (SCA to TSP) for implementation of the following activities as submitted by the State Government vide their letter No. F-17-26/2016/25-2 dated 11.08.2017 & 06.03.2017, and approved by Project Appraisal Committee (PAC) in its meeting dated 18.01.2017:

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2. You may please transfer the amount immediately to the Government of **Chhattisgarh** and advise RBI, CAS, Nagpur for crediting the above mentioned amount to the accounts of the State Government of **Chhattisgarh** in accordance with the procedure laid down in the Ministry of Finance's OM No. 2(45)/ 76-Spl. dated 30.8.1976 as modified by OM of even number dated 16.9.1976 under intimation to TSP Division of the Ministry.

3. State Government shall ensure strict compliance of observations / suggestions made by the PAC in its meeting dated 18.01.2017 during appraisal and approval of the projects submitted by the State Government under SCA to TSP for the year 2016-17.

4. State Government shall ensure immediate transfer of funds to respective implementing agencies for implementation of activities approved by MoTA PAC. Progress Reports of SCA to TSP may be furnished in the format prescribed by MoTA. A Certificate of actual utilization of the grants received for the purpose, for which it has been sanctioned, is to be furnished to the Ministry as per provisions of General Financial Rules (GFR), 212(1) of 2005 amended from time to time.

5. State Government has to ensure that grant-in-aid is used for the purpose for which it is sanctioned after following due procedure in a transparent manner and after obtaining all necessary clearances as required under the various Central/ State Acts, Rules, regulations, etc. In case of construction of infrastructure facilities, norms and Schedule of Rates (SOR) fixed by the State Government should be followed.

6. State Government shall ensure that concerned Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) should be duly informed about the projects / programmes relating to Tribal Development to be implemented in the area of jurisdiction. State Government shall also ensure that meetings of Gram Sabha are conducted on regular intervals as per norms in such areas.

7. No UC is due for rendition.

8. The expenditure to the tune of of **Rs. 17,27,12,000/- (Rupees Seventeen Crore Twenty Seven Lakh Twelve Thousand Only)**, is debitible to the :

- Major Head '3601' - Grants-in-aid to State Governments
- Sub-major Head 02 - Grants for State Plan Schemes
- Minor Head 796 - Tribal Area Sub-Plan
  - 02 - Welfare of Scheduled Tribes – Grants under Proviso to Article 275 (1) of the Constitution.
  - 01 - Scheme under Tribal Sub-Plan (Voted)
  - 02.01.35 - Grants for creation of capital assets (Voted)
- Demand No. - 89 for 2016-17 of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs
