



Status report on implementation of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 [for the period ending 30.09.2025]

Readiness of the States in the implementation of the Act:

- (i) An updated status of State-wise implementation of the Act is given in **Annexure-I**. As per the information collected till now; **51,56,970 claims** (**49,44,083** individual and **2,12,887** community claims) have been filed and **25,13,770 titles** (**23,91,541** individual and **1,22,229** community titles) have been distributed.
- (ii) A total of **43,87,508 (85.08%)** claims have been disposed of.
- (iii) A statement on claims received and distribution of title deeds in various states, as in **Annexure-II**, is being maintained.

(ii) State wise details of claims received, titles distributed and the extent of forest land for which titles distributed (individual and community), as on 30.09.2025, in major States, is indicated below:

S. No.	State/UT	Problems / Remarks- Provided in Affidavit to Supreme Court in Case No. 109/2008
1	Arunachal Pradesh	The State Government has informed that Arunachal Pradesh is a 100 % tribal dominated state and almost all lands are wholly possessed by the various ethnic tribal groups. As such, there is no instance of eviction of forest dwellers who have been dwelling in the Forest even before implementation of the Act, 2006. Consequently, there are no claims of Forest received under this Act, 2006.
2	Haryana	The State Govt. has informed that there are no Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers living in the forests of Haryana.
3	Manipur	The State Government of Manipur has informed that there has been no substantial progress in the implementation of the Act due to the fact that, apart from reserved forest/ wildlife sanctuaries, the tribal communities and Tribal Chiefs are already holding ownership of forest land as it is their ancestral land. Therefore, implementation of said Act is minimal.
4	Meghalaya	Earlier, the State Government had submitted that it has 76.44% area under forest cover, amongst which only 5.10% area is under direct administrative control of the State Forest Department in the form of Reserved Forests, Protected Forests, Protected areas, and rest of the forest areas are either privately or community owned. The major portion of forest areas are owned and administered by the traditional institutions like Syiem, Dollo, Nokma and communities are enjoying surface rights and sub-surface rights since time immemorial. It was further stated that Gram Sabha is absent due to application of 6 th Schedule Area. The State Government is in the process of identifying a suitable institution or elected village committee to substitute the Gram Sabha to facilitate implementation of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights), Act, 2006. <i>Recently, on 4th September 2025, the Government of Meghalaya informed about the constitution of DLC for the implementation of FRA in East Khasi Hills District, Shillong.</i>
5	Mizoram	Earlier, the State Government informed that, nearly 100% of the population of Mizoram are Scheduled Tribes and they share common ownership of non- reserved forest land under the jurisdiction of every village. Hence, the issue of deprivation or rejection of rights has never arisen to date, as forest ownership rights have been recognized and vested in the hands of the community of every village since time immemorial. <i>Recently, the Governor of Mizoram has passed an order dated 21.08.2024 to adopt the implementation of FRA in Mizoram State. No progress has been updated thereafter.</i>
6	Nagaland	The Government of Nagaland informed that in the State of Nagaland, the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 is not applicable in view of the provisions of Article 371 A of the Constitution which gives special status to the State of Nagaland with regard to the rights of the people over land and its resources. The inhabitants of the State are predominantly tribal with distinct linguistic, cultural, traditional, customary, and socio- political characteristics and also the land and Forests belongs to the private individuals, clans or communities in the villages and land holding and resources therein are governed by traditional and

		customary practices of the people. That the said Article also specifically provides that No Act of Parliament in respect of ownership and transfer of land and its resources, shall apply to the State of Nagaland unless the Legislative Assembly of Nagaland by a resolution so decides. That in view of the said provision of the Constitution, there is no resolution passed by the Legislative Assembly to make the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006 applicable to the State of Nagaland.
7	Sikkim	The Government of Sikkim has informed that in Sikkim, there are no Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers in the true sense of the terms. Most of the STs of Sikkim hold revenue land in their own name and they are not solely dependent on the forests for their livelihood.
8	A&N Islands	The Andaman & Nicobar Administration has informed that, the area inhabited by the Scheduled Tribes in the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands has been declared as Reserved Areas under the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes). Their interests are fully protected under the said regulation by exclusively preserving the area for them in which they enjoy unfettered rights to use forests products for their bonafide use. Therefore, no claim as such for recognition under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006. There are no traditional forest dwellers residing on the forest/ land / tribal reserve for the bonafide livelihood needs for three generations (75 years), prior to 13.12.2005 for the purpose of recognition of forest rights under the above- said Act. The UT had reported NIL progress vide their communication received in the month of January 2022.
9	D&N Haveli Daman & Diu	The Administration of Daman & Diu has informed that, as per records of Forest Department, no village in the District of Daman and Diu has been declared as a forest village so far.
10	Lakshadweep	The UT Administration has intimated that there are no terrestrial forests and no forest tribes or traditional forest dwellers in Lakshadweep.
11	Puducherry	The UT has submitted that there are no recorded forests i.e. Reserved or Protected Forest land in Puducherry. The notified Scheduled Tribes in the UT do not reside on Forest Land; hence as such the "Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006" is not applicable to the Union Territory of Puducherry.
12	Ladakh	Ladakh has also started the process of FRA and furnished the NIL data for MPR.
