

CIRCULAR

The undersigned is directed to say that the Ministry of Tribal Affairs has framed a fresh Recruitment Rules for the post of Office Superintendent Group B Non - Gazetted Ministerial in the National Commission for Scheduled Tribes (NCST).

As per DoPT OM no AB-14017/61/2008-Estt. (RR) dated 13.10.2015, it is mentioned that before referring any proposal for framing/amendment in the Recruitment Rules of any Post in Ministries/Departments and their subordinate and attached office, the proposed amendments/revision in the Recruitment Rules would be put up on the website of the respective Ministries/Departments for 30 days for inviting comments from the stakeholders.

Accordingly, the circular is being placed on the website of this Ministry for comments from the stakeholders, if any, to frame the fresh RRs for the post of Office Superintendent Group B Non - Gazetted Ministerial in the National Commission for Scheduled Tribes (NCST).

NOTIFICATION

NEW DELHI, THE2022

G.S.R. - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Office Superintendent in the National Commission for Scheduled Tribes, namely: -

1. Short title and commencement. - (1) These rules may be called the National Commission for Scheduled Tribes, Office Superintendent (Group B) Recruitment Rules, 2022.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application. - These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these Rules.

3. Initial Constitution. - (1) The incumbents holding the post of Office Superintendent on regular basis, immediately before the commencement of these rules, shall be deemed to have been appointed in accordance with the provisions of these rules.

(2) The regular continuous service of incumbents referred to above in the grade immediately before the commencement of these rules shall count for the purpose of probation period, seniority, qualifying service for promotion, confirmation and pension in the service.

4. Number of Posts, classification, level in pay matrix. - The number of the said posts, their classification, pay level in the pay matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the aforesaid Schedule.

5. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification etc.- The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

6. Disqualification. - No person, -

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

7. Power to relax. – Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

8. Saving. - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the scheduled Tribes, the ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Deputation (including short term contract):

Officers of the Central Government, State Governments, Union Territories, autonomous or statutory organizations, PSUs, Universities or Recognized Research Institutions: -

(a)(i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or

(ii) with six years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the posts in level 5 in the pay matrix (Rs.29200-92300) or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; or

(iii) with ten years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the posts in level 4 in the pay matrix (Rs.25500-81100) or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; and

(b) having two years' experience in administration, establishment and accounts matters.

Note 1: The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation and similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2: Period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment

in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed three years.

Note 3: The maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding fifty-six years as on the closing date of receipt or applications.
