Minutes of meeting held through Video Conferencing (VC) on 28.02.2024 and 01.03.2024 in respect of Andhra Pradesh, Jharkhand, Kerala, Telangana, Chhattisgarh and Uttar Pradesh States

A meeting of the Committee was held on 28.02.2023 and 01.03.2024for appraisal of proposals of Government of Andhra Pradesh, Jharkhand, Kerala, Telangana, Chhattisgarh and Uttar Pradesh for MultiPurpose Centres (MPCs) under PM JANMAN under the Chairpersonship of Dr. Naval Jit Kapoor, Additional Secretary, Ministry of Tribal Affairs. - 2. At the outset, it was apprised that the Ministry has allocated 657 MPCs to 15 States including State(s) of Andhra Pradesh, Jharkhand, Kerala, Telangana, Chhattisgarh and Uttar Pradesh. Further, State Governments have been asked to expedite uploading of progress on the module of Gatishakti Portal devised for the purpose. It was further reiterated that the opening of SLS& SNA account, DPR finalization, issuance of tender document and identification of construction agency needs to be expedited as per extant guidelines. Ministry is in receipt of fresh proposals of construction of multi-Purpose Centers (MPCs) from States of Andhra Pradesh, Jharkhand, Kerala, Telangana Chhattisgarh and Uttar Pradesh. The

proposals in respect of each state are examined and following observations are offered there on-

#### **Andhra Pradesh**

- 3. In the case of Andhra Pradesh, it was apprised that targets for the State for construction of MPCs is 125 and Ministry has already sanctioned construction of 72 MPCs and approved Rs 4320.00 lakhs (@Rs 60.00 lakh per MPC as per MPC guideline) and Rs.1496.88 lakhs have been released during current financial year. Now, the Government of Andhra Pradesh, Tribal Development Departmenthas submitted details of additional 71proposals of MPCs.
- 4. The state made a detailed presentation on this issue and justified the requirement of MPCs at the locations proposed by the state. After the detailed discussion with state, the committee observed that 53 number of locations (Annexure I) proposed by state is broadly covered under the guidelines of MPCs whereas for remaining 18 locations PAC differed the proposals with advice to State to reexamine these proposals and come up with the updated inputs as discussed in meeting.

#### **Jharkhand**

- 5. In the case of Jharkhand, it was apprised that targets for the State for construction of MPCs is 100 and Ministry has already sanctioned construction of 3 MPCs approved Rs 180.00 lakhs (@Rs 60.00 lakh per MPC as per MPC guideline) and Rs.62.37 lakhs have been released during current financial year. Now, the Government of Jharkhand, Tribal Development Departmenthas submitted details of additional 60proposals of MPCs.
- 6. The state made a detailed presentation on this issue and justified the requirement of MPCs at the locations proposed by the state. After the detailed discussion with state, the committee observed that 16 number of locations (Annexure II (i)) proposed by state is broadly covered under the guidelines of MPCs whereas for remaining 44 locations PAC differed the proposals with advice to state to reexamine these proposals and come up with the updated inputs.
- 7. Further, on 01.03.2024 PAC, the Government of Jharkhand, Tribal Development Department has submitted details of additional 28 proposals of MPCs. The state made a detailed presentation on this issue and justified the requirement of MPCs at the locations proposed by the state. After the detailed discussion with state, the committee observed that 27 number of locations (Annexure II (ii)) proposed by state is broadly covered under the guidelines of MPCs whereas for remaining 1 location PAC deferred the proposals with advice to state to reexamine these proposals and come up with the updated inputs. The state was also advised that the remaining MPCs should be fairly distributed amongst uncovered districts.

#### Kerala

- 8. In the case of Kerala, it was apprised that targets for the State for construction of MPCs is 15 and Ministry has already sanctioned construction of 14 MPCs approved Rs 840.00 lakhs (@Rs 60.00 lakh per MPC as per MPC guideline) and Rs.226.69 lakhs have been released during current financial year. Now, the Government of Kerala, Tribal Development Departmenthas submitted details of additional 1proposal of MPCs.
- 9. The state made a detailed presentation on this issue and justified the requirement of MPCs at the locations proposed by the state. After the detailed discussion with state, the committee observed that 1 location (**Annexure III**) proposed by State is broadly covered under the guidelines of MPCs.
- 10. Also, the Government of Kerala, Tribal Area Development Department has proposed for change of locations with respect to 3 MPC locations namely, Thodulkad, Koloor and Anapanthi previously approved by PAC and submitted details of revised proposals of 3 MPCs viz. Thalikakallu, Aranamala and Vattakkund.
- 11.In this reference, Government of Kerala, Tribal Area Development Department stated that earlier the State Government has proposed the MPCs keeping in view the Beneficiary at Thodukad is land made available at Thodukad hamlet do not have road access. In Koloor, new anganwadi recently built using MP fund and at Anapanthi the earlier proposed land is not available for MPC at Anappanthi hamlet.

### Telangana

- 12.In the case of Telangana, it was apprised that targets for the State for construction of MPCs is 50 and Ministry has already sanctioned construction of 14 MPCs approved Rs 840.00 lakhs (@Rs 60.00 lakh per MPC as per MPC guideline) and Rs.291.06 lakhs have been released during current financial year. Now, the Government of Telangana, Tribal Development Departmenthas submitted details of additional 49proposals of MPCs.
- 13. The state made a detailed presentation on this issue and justified the requirement of MPCs at the locations proposed by the state. After the detailed discussion with state, the committee observed that 35 number of locations (Annexure V) proposed by state is broadly covered under the guidelines of MPCs.

### Chhattisgarh

14.In the case of Chhattisgarh, it was apprised that targets for the State for construction of MPCs is 75 and Ministry has already sanctioned construction of 41 MPCs and approved Rs 2460.00 lakhs (@Rs 60.00 lakh per MPC as per MPC guideline) and Rs.852.39 lakhs have been released during current

- financial year. Now, the Government of Chhattisgarh, Tribal Development Department has submitted details of additional 34 proposals of MPCs.
- 15. The state made a detailed presentation on this issue and justified the requirement of MPCs at the locations proposed by the state. After the detailed discussion with state, the committee observed that 32 number of locations (Annexure VI) proposed by state is broadly covered under the guidelines of MPCs whereas for remaining 2 locations PAC deferred the proposals with advice to state to reexamine these proposals and come up with the updated inputs.

#### **Uttar Pradesh**

- 16.In the case of Uttar Pradesh, it was apprised that targets for the State for construction of MPCs is 5 and Ministry has already sanctioned construction of 4 MPCs approved Rs 240.00 lakhs (@Rs 60.00 lakh per MPC as per MPC guideline) and Rs.62.37 lakhs have been released during current financial year. Now, the Government of Uttar Pradesh, Tribal Development Department has submitted details of additional 2 proposals of MPCs.
- 17. The state made a detailed presentation on this issue and justified the requirement of MPCs at the locations proposed by the state. After the detailed discussion with state, the committee observed that 1 number of locations (Annexure VII) proposed by state is broadly covered under the guidelines of MPCs.
- 18. Accordingly, the Committee decided to approve the following of proposals, State-wise, are as under:
  - i. In respect of Andhra Pradesh, the Committee approved construction of 53 new MPCs (asper Annexure-I)along with in-principle approval of total cost ofRs. 3180.00lakhs (@Rs. 60 lakhs per MPC as per MPC guideline x 53 MPC). However, no additional funds will be released during the current financial year and State Government may utilize the fund already released during the current financial year towards the construction of MPCs. The state government was advised to take necessary measures for calling the tenders and allotment of works by following transparent procedure.
  - ii. In respect of **Jharkhand**, the Committee approved construction of **43** new MPCs{as per Annexure II (i)&Annexure II (ii)} along with inprinciple approval of total cost of Rs. 2580.00 lakhs (@Rs. 60 lakhs per MPC as per MPC guideline x 43 MPC). However, no additional funds will be released during the current financial year and State Government may utilize the fund already released during the current financial year towards the construction of MPCs. The state government was advised to take necessary measures for calling the tenders and allotment of works by following transparent procedure.
  - iii. In respect of **Kerala**, the Committee approved construction of **1 new**MPCs (as per Annexure III) along with in-principle approval of total

cost ofRs. 60.00lakhs (@Rs. 60 lakhs per MPC as per MPC guideline x 1 MPC). However, no additional funds will be released during the current financial year and State Government may utilize the fund already released during the current financial year towards the construction of MPCs. The state government was advised to take necessary measures for calling the tenders and allotment of works by following transparent procedure. Also the Committee approved change of location of 3 already approved MPCs to new locations in the same districts (as per **Annexure – IV).** 

- iv. In respect of **Telangana**, the Committee approved construction of **35 new MPCs**(as per **Annexure V)**along with in-principle approval of total cost of Rs. 2100.00 lakhs (@Rs. 60 lakhs per MPC as per MPC guideline x 35 MPC). However, no additional funds will be released during the current financial year and State Government may utilize the fund already released during the current financial year towards the construction of MPCs. The state government was advised to take necessary measures for calling the tenders and allotment of works by following transparent procedure.
- v. In respect of Chhattisgarh, the Committee approved construction of 32 new MPCs (as per Annexure-VI) along with in-principle approval of total cost of Rs. 1920.00 lakhs (@Rs. 60 lakhs per MPC as per MPC guideline x 32 MPC). However, no additional funds will be released during the current financial year and State Government may utilize the fund already released during the current financial year towards the construction of MPCs. The state government was advised to take necessary measures for calling the tenders and allotment of works by following transparent procedure. The ownership of the land should be transferred in the name of State TWD, where land has been donated by a private party in one instance before starting construction on the land.
- vi. In respect of **Uttar Pradesh**, the Committee approved construction of **1 new MPC** i.e. Chaturwala village (as per **Annexure VII**) along with in-principle approval of total cost of Rs. 60.00 lakhs (@Rs. 60 lakhs per MPC as per MPC guideline x 1 MPC). However, no additional funds will be released during the current financial year and State Government may utilize the fund already released during the current financial year towards the construction of MPCs. The state government was advised to take necessary measures for calling the tenders and allotment of works by following transparent procedure.
- vii. The total number of MPC units approved for each State has now increased to **822** from 657 MPCs sanctioned earlier (481 MPC sanctioned on 12.01.2024 and 09 MPCs sanctioned on 06.02.2024 plus 167 MPC sanctioned on 21.02.2024) plus 165 sanctioned on 28.02.2024and 01.03.2024. All these **165** MPCs are approved in principle now. The State-wise details of number of MPCs sanctioned are at **Annexure-VIII**. The state can approach for release of funds in

next year after the submission of UC and compliance of SNA requirements.

- 19. The Committee approved the above proposals with following conditions to be followed by the State Governments:
  - i. The State should ensure that the land identified for the purpose is adequateforconstruction of the center and ownership of the land has been transferred in the name of State TWD.
  - ii. In the case of infrastructure facilities, norms and schedule of rates (SoR) fixed bytheStateGovernment needtobefollowed.Theconstructionmustbecarried out only on Government / Publicland.
  - iii. Recommendation of DLCC and approval of Principal Secretary on the proposal has been obtained.
  - iv. Construction of the MPC is carried out by State Govt. Agency, or any otheragencyidentifiedbytheStatefollowingtheprescribedprocedureand fiscal prudence in a transparent manner as per stipulatedtimeline.
  - v. Construction cost of the Centre including furniture, fixture, fittings, and otherbasicrequirementsforthecentredoesnotexceedRs.60lakhs.
  - vi. The State will also ensure that all necessary clearances whether under Centralor State Act/Rules/Regulations is obtained by the State.
  - vii. The State will ensure that technical scrutiny of estimates for the work is done by competent authority as per provisions of DFPR applicable in the state and project is executed by Govt. agency in a transparent manner.
  - viii. The State TWD will submit a detailed report to MoTA after complying with the above stipulations by the Ministry. A dedicated module has been created in PM Gati Shakti Portal. The data in respect of these MPCs need to be updated on the PM-Gatishakti Portal. The financial and physical progress of the MPC needs to be updated on Portal.
    - ix. Wherever there is Anganwadi or Mini Anganwadi with staff and Anganwadi and Anganwadi is kachha, the same will be shifted to the MPC. Further if there is Pucca Anganwadi with staff in the same habitation/village where MPC is approved, no separate staff for Anganwadi will be provided in the MPC.
    - x. The State should finalise mechanisms for maintenance of these MPCs as per guidelines and coordinate with the concerned line departments for provision of staff.
