





MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE APEX COMMITTEE HELD ON 2ND JUNE 2017 AT 3.00 PM UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF ECONOMIC ADVISER MINISTRY OF TRIBAL AFFAIRS (MoTA) TO DISCUSS THE ANNUAL PLANS OF TRIBAL RESEARCH INSTITUTES IN THE CONFERENCE ROOM, G-59, AUGUST KRANTI BHAWAN, BHIKAJI CAMA PLACE, NEW DELHI.

A meeting of the Apex Committee was held under the Chairmanship of Economic Adviser MoTA on 2nd June 2017 at 3.00 PM in Conference Room, G-59, August Kranti Bhawan, Bhikaji Cama Place, New Delhi, to discuss the Annual Plan of the Tribal Research Institutes (TRIs). The list of the participants is enclosed at Annexure A".

2. At the outset, EA MoTA welcomed the participants. Initiating the discussion, EA, MoTA informed that the Pending outstanding Utilisation Certificates (UCs), Statement of Expenditure (SoE) and Physical Progress Reports (PPRs) should be submitted by the States / TRIs immediately, if not already done. This would facilitate release of funds for this year on time. The UCs should clearly show year-wise utilisation against the sanction released. Previous year's transfer / adjustment should be reflected separately and clearly. The break-up of expenditure for different activities should be furnished in the SoE. The SoE and PPR should clearly indicate the activities approved by MoTA along with deliverables / outcomes. Funds should not be diverted from the approved plans. For individual beneficiary based activities (in kind or in cash i.e. Direct Benefit Transfer), Aadhar Number should be obtained. Beneficiaries should be selected in a transparent manner. List of beneficiaries with their address and amount of benefit should be uploaded on the website of the State Government but the Bank Account, Aadhar Number, Mobile number etc. should not be uploaded due to security and privacy concerns. Construction projects / works should be completed by December 2018.
3. JS (Admn) Shri Rajesh Agarwal requested all the State Govt. /TRIs to send the Research / Evaluation Studies undertaken by TRIs in the last five years alongwith specific policy issues addressed in these studies. All the documented activities are to be provided to this Ministry in [Soft copy as far as possible. Activities funding should not be repeated by any TRI, if it is already conducted in the past by TRI/ any other agencies. Best practices / success stories on Tribal Development should be intimated to this Ministry from time to time so that it can be replicated in other States for implementation. Further, regarding proposal for Evaluation study of ITDA, JS (Admin), Suggested to take this Proposal through other Scheme of MoTA.
4. It was again pointed out by some of the representatives of TRIs that funds are not transferred to TRI from the State Governments on regular basis in time & therefore the completion of activities are being delayed. EA directed the TRIs to inform the Ministry of such cases so that the matter should be taken up with the concerned State Government for doing the needful.
