The Ministry of Tribal Affairs, in collaboration with the Centre for Nano Science and Engineering (CeNSE), IISc, has launched a program to train tribal students and faculty in semiconductor technology, aligned with the India Semiconductor Mission (ISM). The program aims to train 450 students and faculty from tribal communities on semiconductor manufacturing technology.

The training is primarily based on the facilities available at CeNSE, and covers a variety of research topics under the broad umbrella of nano science and engineering.
