Sir,

In continuation of this Ministry's sanction letter of even number dated 25.07.2017, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to release an amount of **Rs. 519.65 Lakhs (Rupees. Five crore nineteen lakhs sixty five thousand only)** as grants-in-aid to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Research & Training Institute, Bhubaneswar, Govt. of Odisha, under the Scheme "Support to TRIs" for 2017-18 to carry out the activities approved by APEX Committee of the Ministry in its meeting dated 02.06.2017 and 27.11.2017. The details of the activities approved by APEX Committee for the year 2017-18 is at Annexure.

2. You may please transfer the amount immediately to the Government of Odisha and advise RBI, CAS, Nagpur for crediting the above mentioned amount to the accounts of the State Government of Odisha in accordance with the procedure laid down in the Ministry of Finance's OM No. 2(45)/ 76-Spl. dated 30.8.1976 as modified by OM of even number dated 16.9.1976 under intimation to TRI Division of the Ministry.

3. The grant should be utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned and should not be diverted for any other activities.

4. As per Rule 236(1) of GFR-2017, the accounts of the Organizations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) Act 1971 and Internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organization is called upon to do so.




7. The financial assistance sanctioned is provisional subject to final adjustment on the basis of audit figures of expenditure.
