4. The expenditure to the tune of **Rs. 10,17,500/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Seventeen Thousand Five Hundred Only)**, is debatable to the :

5. The State Government will organize the competition within the amount released by the Ministry during 2018-19 and keeping in view the spirit of the Competition and the following guidelines:

Common Guidelines

- a. Selection Criteria : EMRS students between classes 6 – 12th (both boys and girls) (School with only 6th class shall be excluded)

- b. Group Composition: 10 -12 number of students (equal number of boys and girls)
- c. Theme: The group song should bring out the feelings and emotions related to patriotism, inspiration, national unity & pride and national brotherhood.
- d. Language: Hindi or any regional language. Songs preferably should be multilingual capturing the essence of linguistic diversity.
- e. Attire: The participating students should be dressed in their respective school uniform.
- f. Judgment Criteria: Theme (30), Lyrics (30) and Tune (40) = Total 100 marks.

The competition will be held at the School Level followed by Regional Level Competition and finally culminating with a National Level Competition.

6. The State Government has to ensure that grant-in-aid is used for the purpose for which it is sanctioned after following due procedure in a transparent manner and after obtaining all necessary clearances as required.
7. This sanction issues in exercise of the delegated powers in consultation with Integrated Finance of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs vide their FTS No. 12738/JS&FA/2018 dated 30.11.2018
8. Certified that this sanction has been noted at S. No. ⁵⁰ in the register of grants.
