Subject: Grants under Proviso to Article 275(1) of Constitution during 2018-19 to the 8 States under Creation of Capital Assets (Non-Recurring) for setting up 16 Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRSs) and 3 Eklavya Model Day Boarding Schools (EMDBSs) and 1 Center for Excellence in Sports

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for release of an amount of **Rs. 26,90,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Six Crore Ninety Lakh only)** as 1st installment on adhoc basis to the State Governments of 8 States as detailed below towards Creation of Capital Assets for Grants under Article 275(1) of the Constitution during the year 2018-19 to carry out Setting up of 16 Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRSs) and 3 Eklavya Model Day Boarding Schools (EMDBSs) and 1 Center for Excellence in Sports (@ Rs. 136.00 lakh per EMRS and Rs. 136.00 lakh per EMDBS and Rs. 1.27 per Center for Excellence in Sports) as approved in the PAC meeting held between 11th February, 2019 to 13th February, 2019, as under:


3. No UC is due for rendition.

4. The expenditure to the tune of **Rs. 26,90,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Six Crore Ninety Lakh only)** is debitable to the :

Major Head '3601' - Grants-in-aid to State Governments
Sub-major Head 08 - Other Transfer/Grants to States
Minor Head 796 - Tribal Area Sub-Plan
05 - Welfare of Scheduled Tribes – Grants under Proviso to Article 275 (1) of the Constitution.
01 - Grants under Proviso to Article 275(1) of the Constitution (Charged)
05.01.35 - Grants for creation of capital assets (Charged)
Demand No. - 96 for 2018-19 of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs

5. The State Government will implement the projects within the amount released by the Ministry and keeping in view the spirit of the provisions contained under Operational Guidelines for Inter-State allocation of funds and implementation of Programmes / Activities under Proviso to Article 275(1) of Constitution of India, issued by Ministry of Tribal Affairs vide this Ministry's letter NO. 11015/01/2016-SG-I dated 20.6.2016 and other relevant instructions issued from time to time. Besides the following norms should be followed strictly :

- i. An Autonomous Society under the Ministry of Tribal Affairs similar to Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti shall be established to run the EMRSs. This Society will be responsible to establish, endow, maintain, control and manage EMRSs and to do all acts and things necessary for or conducive to tribal education. There will be Steering and Executive Committees to be notified subsequently as also the various academic framework and logistic parameters viz. recruitment of teachers, enhancement of facilities, on boarding of existing EMRSs, curriculum etc. Till the time this Society and other essential parameters are notified and are in place, the current setup of running the EMRSs as per the existing framework will continue.
- ii. State Governments to furnish Detailed Project Reports (DPR) for each projects for consideration of the Steering Committee in the Ministry, immediately.

- iii. Construction of the newly approved Schools will also be done as per Government of India Rules including those from Central Government and State Government agencies. For newly sanctioned EMRS/EMDBS, the construction agency shall be appointed by the Central Government. However, during the transition phase, the new approved EMRS/EMDBS shall be constructed by the State/UT Government as per practice hitherto. The EMRS/ EMDBS / Centers of Excellence for Sports buildings should be completed within 2 years from the date of release of final installment.
- iv. EMRS / EMDBS sanctioned during 2018-19 should be made functional from 2019-20, wherever feasible, in rented buildings (preferably Government buildings).
- v. The District and the Block should not be changed without seeking prior approval from the Ministry.
- vi. These sanctioned EMRS and EMDBS need to follow CBSE curriculum.
- vii. Utilization of upto 10% seats by non-ST students. Priority shall be given to children of EMRSs staff, children who have lost their parents to Left wing extremism and insurgencies, children of widows, children of divyang parents etc.
- viii. Reservation of 20% seats under sports quota for deserving ST students who have excelled in the field of sports.
- ix. Preference shall be given to students from Particularly Vulnerable Tribal groups (PVTG) community at the time of admission.

6. The State Government shall ensure that concerned Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) should be duly informed about the projects for Tribal Education to be implemented in the area of jurisdiction.

7. The State Government has to ensure that grant-in-aid is used for the purpose for which it is sanctioned after following due procedure in a transparent manner and after obtaining all necessary clearances as required under the various Central/ State Acts, Rules, regulations, etc. In case of construction of infrastructure facilities, norms and Schedule of Rates (SOR) fixed by the State Government should be followed.

8. The progress reports of every quarter should be furnished indicating the physical and financial progress as per prescribed format already circulated and revised from time to time. A Certificate of actual utilization of the grants received for the purpose for which it was received, may be furnished to the Ministry within 12 months of the closure of the financial year by the State Government.

9. This sanction issues in exercise of the delegated powers in consultation with Integrated Finance of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs vide their FTS No. 13755/JS&FA/2018 dated 26.02.2019.
