Subject:- Release of 1st installment to Kalinga Institute of Social Science(KISS), Bhubaneswar for organizing National Seminar on "State, Civil Society and Public policy: Towards Tribal Development in India" during the year 2018-19.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the President of India to release of Rs.67,500/- (Rupees Sixty Seven Thousand Five Hundred only) to Kalinga Institute of Social Science(KISS), Bhubaneswar for organizing National Seminar on "State, Civil Society and Public policy: Towards Tribal Development in India" during the year 2018-19 under the scheme "Tribal Festival, Research Information and Mass Education".

2. The Grant is sanctioned under the scheme of "Tribal Festival, Research Information and Mass Education". The Research Study will be guided by the Terms of Reference enclosed with this sanction order. The provisions of General Financial rule 231 (1) would be applicable where the Voluntary Organization is being provided assistance for the prescribed amount.

3. The grants-in-aid is subjected to the General financial Rules, 2017, as amended from time to time, read with the Government of India's decisions incorporated there – under and any other guidelines which may be issued in this regard and in particular to the following conditions:-

- I) All relevant information and documents/certificates as required under GFR-209 shall be furnished by the grantee.
- II) Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of Government Grants shall not be disposed of without obtaining the prior approval of the sanctioning authority of Grant-in-aid.
- III) The institution will not obtain grant for the same purpose or activity (the purpose for which grant is sanctioned to it under the Scheme of "Tribal Festival, Research Information and Mass Education" from any other Ministry or Department of Govt. of India or State Government.
- IV) The grantee institution agrees to make reservations for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes or OBC in the posts or services under its control on the lines indicated by Govt. of India.
- V) The accounts of institution shall be open for inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller & Auditor General of India under the provision of C&AG (DPC Act,

1971) and Internal Audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department whenever it is called upon to do so.

VI) The grantee should furnish their performance-cum-achievement report within three months of the date of receiving the 1st instalment of grant, to the sanctioning Authority.

VII) The grantee will spend Grants-in-aid exclusively in pursuance of the objectives envisaged in rules/memorandum of Kalinga Institute of Social Science(KISS) and for the purposes it is being sanctioned. The University will not divert grant in aid or entrust the execution of the project for which the grant-in-aid is sanctioned to another organization or institution. No funds out of this grant should be utilized for any new scheme for which prior approval of Government has not been obtained.

VIII) The grantee will maintain and present its annual accounts in the standard format as required under GFR- 209 and will maintain subsidiary accounts of the Govt. grant.

IX) The grantee will maintain subsidiary accounts of the Govt. Grant as required under GFR-210.

X) Ten percent of the grant-in-aid sanctioned will be released after the receipt of the following documents:

a) Two hard copies (including a soft copy in C.D.) of the proceedings of seminar/workshop which inter-alia should include:

- (i) The objective of the Seminar/Workshop;
- (ii) Programme/schedule of the seminar/workshop;
- (iii) A copy each of the papers contributed;
- (iv) List of invitees/participants along with their complete addresses;
- (v) Photographs of participants and resource persons;
- (vi) Recommendations in brief vis-a-vis the objectives;
- (vii) Follow up actions initiated/ to be initiated by the organisation.

b) Audited statement of accounts and Utilization certificate (In GFR 19A format) of sanctioned amount duly certified by the Chartered Accountant.

4. It is certified that the pattern of assistance and rules governing the grants-in-aid have received the approval of Ministry of Finance.

5. The expenditure involved will be met from within the sanctioned Budget amount of Ministry of Tribal Affairs under Major Head 2225 – Welfare of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, other Backward Classes and Minorities, Sub Major Head – 02 – Welfare to Scheduled Tribes, 796 – Tribal Area Sub plan (Minor Head) 21 – Umbrella programme for Development of Scheduled Tribes : Van Bandhu Kalyan Yojana 04 Tribal festival, Research information and Mass Education 21.04.31 – Grant-in-aid General under Demand No. 96 of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs for the year 2018-19.
