Sub: Grants-in-aid to the State Government of Jammu & Kashmir towards arrear grant for the year 2017-18(4th installment) under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Post Matric Scholarships to ST students, during the year 2018-19.

Sir,

In continuation of this Ministry's sanction letter No. 20014/11/2012-Edu/Sch. dated 25th March 2019, sanction of the President of India is hereby conveyed for Rs.1382.29 lakhs and to release an amount of **Rs.4,71,47,000/- (Rupees Four Crore Seventy-One Lakh Forty-Seven Thousand only)**, (after adjusting unspent amount of Rs.744.36 lakhs), to the **Government of Jammu & Kashmir** under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Post Matric Scholarships to ST students towards arrear grant upto the year 2017-18(4th Installment) during the year 2018-19.

2. This sanction relates to Plan Expenditure and is in accordance with the pattern of assistance prescribed by the Planning Commission and subject to the provision of General Financial Rules, 2017 as amended from time to time and any other instructions issued in this regard.

You are requested to advise RBI, CAS, Nagpur for crediting the above mentioned amount to the account of **Government of Jammu & Kashmir** in accordance with procedure laid down in the Ministry of Finance's OM No. 2(45)76-Spl.Cell dated 30-8-1976 as modified vide OM of even number dated 16-09-1976.

8. No utilization certificate is due for rendition.

9. Diversion of funds and deviation from the norms of the scheme shall not be allowed. State Government has no authority to divert the funds for other purpose.
