

	<p>TRI has submitted detailed proposal for renovation of existing museum in the TRI building for which an amount of Rs.288.02 lakhs has been sought and has also submitted a proposal for renovation of TRI building for an amount of Rs.197.872 lakhs. On examination of proposal for reconstruction of TRI building, it is seen that the items at S.No.4 to 6 are related to renovation of museum. It was explained that the museum and TRI building are in the same complex and the museum requires renovation. The PAC after deliberations approved an amount of Rs.151.79 lakhs for the proposed reconstruction of TRI Building. The PAC asked the TRI to re-examine the proposal of renovation of museum, which will be taken separately. It was remarked by the Secretary, Tribal Affairs that during the inspection of the tribal freedom fighters museum at Ranchi recently, it was observed that some fundamental aspects related to seepage and drainage to be attended on top priority. It is essential to take corrective action needed after the rainy season has ended now, so that the newly constructed museum does not get damaged. Besides, some related works of museum like utilizing other halls and space may be considered, while making the proposal for renovation. As far as the renovation / reconstruction of TRI building is concerned, proper technical feasibility should be examined, and approval of competent authorities must be obtained. Quality of construction should be got supervised through a reputed institution like NIT.</p>
