Subject: Grants under Proviso Article 275(1) of Constitution during 2024-25 to the State Government of Madhya Pradesh (Creation of Capital Assets).

Sir,

In continuation of this Ministry's letter even dated 30.09.2024, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for release of an amount of **Rs. 34,32,76,500/- (Rupees Thirty-Four Crore Thirty-Two Lakh and Seventy-Six Thousand Five Hundred only)**, to the Government of **Madhya Pradesh** towards Creation of Capital Assts (CCA) for **Grants under Article 275(1) of the Constitution** for the year 2024-25 to carry out the following activities:

1. Annual Plan under Article 275(1) for financial year 2024-25

PAC has already approved the committed liabilities for Madhya Pradesh in its meeting dated 19.09.2024 for an amount of **Rs. 2475.70 lakh** and the same amount has been released to the State.



<p>The PAC observed that the cost submitted by the state is on higher side. PAC directed that the cost norms for of the Hostel should be Rs 2.75 cr for 50 bedded as PM JANMAN norms. For Eklavya Schools, for 480 seats, the cost in plain areas and on the same lines the cost for one 200 bedded school and hostel should be around 16 cr. For residential quarters also, the studio apartments as approved by NESTS should be considered. The PAC approved an amount of Rs. 80 Crore subject to the condition that administrative approval of the DPR of the project, approval by the SLEC is taken and that state needs to determine the actual cost through transparent mechanism.</p> <p>PAC also directed to State that in phase I, 5 of the top location can be taken up subject to the concept being approved by SLEC.</p>

The State Government will implement the projects within the amount released by the Ministry during 2024-25 and keeping in view the spirit of the provisions contained under Operational Guidelines for Inter-State allocation of funds and implementation of Programmes / Activities under Proviso to Article 275(1) of Constitution of India, issued by Ministry of Tribal Affairs vide this Ministry's letter NO. 18015/06/2019-Grants dated 23.04.2020 and other relevant instructions issued from time to time.


6. State Government shall ensure immediate transfer of funds to respective implementing agencies for implementation of activities to be approved by MoTA PAC / Competent Authority. Progress Reports of Grants under Article 275(1) of Constitution of India may be furnished in the format prescribed by MoTA. A Certificate of actual utilization of the grants received for the purpose, for which it has been sanctioned, is to be furnished to the Ministry as per provisions of General Financial Rules (GFR), 2017 amended from time to time.

7. Article 275(1) Grants is an additive to State Plan funds and efforts for Tribal Development. Funds under Article 275(1) Grants must be utilized for raising socio-economic level of Schedule Tribes commensurate with objectives enshrined in para 2.1 and 2.2 of revised guidelines dated 23.04.2020.

8. The State Government has to ensure that grant-in-aid is used for the purpose for which it is sanctioned after following due procedure in a transparent manner and after obtaining all necessary clearances as required under the various Central/ State Acts, Rules, regulations, etc. In case of construction of infrastructure facilities, norms and Schedule of Rates (SOR) fixed by the State Government should be followed.


9. The progress reports of every quarter should be furnished indicating the physical and financial progress as per prescribed format already circulated and revised from time to time. A Certificate of actual utilization of the grants received for the purpose for which it was received, may be furnished to the Ministry as per provision of GFR 2017.

10. This sanction issues in exercise of the delegated powers in consultation with Integrated Finance of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs vide their **FTS No. 27533/JS&FA/2024 dated 11.02.2025.**
